**What:** Each participant is asked to submit an essay, which must be an original composition relating directly to the topic, "What does success mean to me?"

- May be typed (double spaced) or legibly hand-written; one side of paper only
- May be stapled once but no folders or paper clips
- Writer's name may not appear in the body of the essay
- No fewer than 300 words or more than 450 words
- This form must accompany the essay with the appropriate signatures

These same winners will be invited to attend the luncheon on **Saturday, April 11, 2026 at the INFBPW State Convention in Edinburg, IN.**

- Each District winner will receive a Certificate and a \$50 Cash Award.
- The 1<sup>st</sup> place State Winner will be announced at the State Convention. The State Winner will read their essay and receive an engraved plaque and a \$100 Cash award.
